

#### **Recovery - Domestic Travel**



### No Chnage in India's Top 5 Airports in 5 Years


Delhi is the leading Airport in India followed by Mumbai and Bengaluru. Though new airports have come up but the shares of top airports to total traffic saw


### Indigo is the Top Ranking Airline
